Eligibility

The Fall Scramble is open to both male and female golfers. There are no handicap index eligibility requirements. The field will be limited to 36 teams of 3 players.

Entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time, including during the Championship. Reasons for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. Unbecoming conduct in any City of Ann Arbor event may result in future entries being denied.

Format

Competition will be 18 holes at stroke play, scramble format. Male competitors will play from the black tees and female competitors will play from the white tees.

Sunday, September 16, 2007 – 18 holes.

Play will begin with a shotgun start at 8:00 a.m. Each player shall attempt every shot. The team shall determine the best of the three shots. This process will continue until the ball is holed. Balls may be played from anywhere within the teeing ground for tee shots, and from within six inches for all other shots, except that on the putting surface all shots must be played from the exact spot.

Prizes

Gift certificates will be awarded to the first, second, third, and fourth place teams. Prizes will be awarded also for individual hole contests. All prizes will conform to USGA Rules of Amateur Status. The awards ceremony will be held at the players' banquet following the conclusion of play. The ceremony is open to all. Meals for non-competitors are available at \$15.00 each.

Rules of Golf

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Approved Local Rules and Conditions will be published and distributed prior to play on the day of the Championship. Questions will be settled by the Committee for the Championship, whose decisions shall be final. The competition is deemed to be closed when the awards ceremony has concluded.

Golf Balls

Only brands of golf balls on the most recent USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. This list is updated monthly and may be found on the USGA website at www.usga.org.

Footwear

It is a condition of the competition that shoes with either traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or, regardless of design, spikes comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. *Penalty for breach of this condition: Disqualification.*

Transportation

Competitors are permitted to use motorized transportation during championship rounds. Players, especially those with caddies, are encouraged to familiarize themselves with Decisions 6-4/2.5, 6-4/3, 19/1, 19/2, and 33-8/4 of the USGA Decisions on the Rules of Golf.

Caddies

Competitors may provide their own caddie for the championship rounds. Caddies are not available at Leslie Park Golf Course. Caddies are not permitted during practice rounds.

Time of Starting

All players must be present, on the tee, and ready to play at the time laid down by the Committee. The order of play is not relevant. The optional condition for time of starting prescribed in Appendix I of *The Rules of Golf* will be in effect: *If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.* A competitor is solely responsible for timely arrival at the correct teeing ground.

Field Determination

The Tournament Director reserves the right to adjust the field with respect to size and composition at his or her discretion after the posted registration deadline. Generally, vacancies in the field will be filled in order of the established waiting list. The Tournament Director reserves the right, however, to pass over individuals on the waiting list if contact cannot be made immediately using the information supplied by individuals on the waiting list.

Conditions, Schedules

The Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Committee in any matter shall be final.

Tournament Information

Information concerning pairings, starting times, etc., will be sent in player's memo approximately 7-14 days prior to the event. If you have not received your information within seven days of the event, it is the player's sole responsibility to contact Leslie Park Golf Course. **DO NOT CALL MORE THAN SEVEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT!**

Refund Policy

Refunds will be granted according to the schedule below. The Tournament Director reserves the right to grant exceptions to the stated policy in situations including, but not limited to injury, illness, and death in the family.
